Venue: Christchurch Convention Centre and Town Hall
Location: Christchurch New Zealand South Island

Proposed length of Congress: 14 days
Probable climate: Warm summer time.

General: There are simultaneous translation facilities, in or out house catering and many possibilities for youth and cultural activities. Internet connections available.

Visas: Though many countries require visas, these are usually easily given, one reason maybe being that it is an Island and thus easier to control, with no concerns from 'neighbouring countries

Population Christchurch: 300.000

Description of the area: Located in the Central City it has many, nearby parks, a river, golf course, swimming, walking, ocean with wildlife such as whales, seals, and dolphins.
